

Brief CV of Professor Charles V Sammut

Charles Sammut holds a BA in Education from UM (1980), a BSc in Physics with Physical Electronics (First Class Honours) (1987) and a PhD in the field of microwave semiconductor devices (1992) from the University of Bath, UK. He Joined the University of Malta in 1987 and was awarded a Commonwealth Academic Staff Scholarship to read for the PhD degree, for which he was awarded the Deryck Chesterman Medal from Bath University.

He is currently full Professor and Head of the Department of Physics, Dean of the Faculty of Science and leads the Electromagnetics Research Group (EMRG). His current research interests include: dielectric spectroscopy of biological tissues for medical applications; computational electromagnetics; antenna design; exposure of workers and the general public to non-ionising electromagnetic fields; biological effects of non-ionising electromagnetic fields. Professor Sammut is also a Management Committee Member of five COST Actions: TD 1301, BM 1309 and IC 1407.
